RE: December 14, 2009 Finding of Alleged Violation and Order


Dear Mr. Foster:

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) has reviewed the letter from Matt Paque, Associate Staff Counsel for Tronox dated December 10, 2010. The letter formally requests the December 31, 2010 deadline set forth in the ORDER be extended to the Effective Date of Tronox's bankruptcy reorganization.

NDEP will hold in abeyance any enforcement for failure to meet the December 14, 2009 Order requirements, specifically # 7 & 8 provided that Tronox adheres to the approved work plan and that any delays in the implementation does not occur. Any demonstrated noncompliance with the December 14, 2009 other than the December 31, 2010 requirement will necessitate the immediate enforcement action.
