The NDEP has received and reviewed the Trust's above-identified Deliverable and finds that the document is acceptable with the following comments noted for the Administrative Record:

All future semi-annual and annual remedial performance reports should provide following quantitative metrics:

- 1. The concentrations at which NERT is achieving 90% and 99% capture of perchlorate and chromium:
- 2. Monthly perchlorate and chromium mass removal from the Interceptor Well Field (IWF), Athens Road Well Field (AWF) and Seep Well Field (SWF);
- 3. Perchlorate and chromium capture efficiency of IWF, AWF and SWF. The results should be presented as Table 6-1 of the Capture Zone Evaluation Report (Northgate, December 10, 2010):
- 4. Perchlorate and chromium plume mass estimates. The results should be presented as Table 4-1 of the Capture Zone Evaluation Report (Northgate, December 10, 2010);
- 5. Mass loading at Northshore Road.
