**RE:** BCA Meeting to Discuss KMCC Chromium Consent Order

1. Meeting was held on November 3, 2003 in Carson City in the BCA Conference Room at 10:00 AM.
2. Noted that it would be helpful to have the historic analytical data from pond GW-11 for when KMCC proposes to start using this water in the FBR system.
3. Noted that we should request analysis of the influent and effluent to the chromium mitigation system.
4. Discussed what the "big picture" is for KMCC.
  - a. Should the chromium consent order be lumped in to the Phase III Consent Order? This may be several years away.
  - b. Should BCA issue a letter amendment to the existing Consent Order? In this way the discharge limitations would at least be current.
  - c. Should the Consent Order be completely rewritten? This may take 6 months to a year to complete and negotiate.
  - d. Decided to pursue the idea of issuing a letter to KMCC asking them to complete some of the items that are currently deficient.
  - e. Jennifer will review the ideas with Bill Frey.
