(NDEP) Comments on Data Validation Summary Report, Pre-Confirmation

Sampling RZ-E, Dated August 3, 2010.

1. Comment: Please clarify why the reporting the mdl [sic] and pql are in different units than the result and sql? NDEP's preference is to report all in the same units. Additionally, TRX should ensure that the units for the sql is identical to the result units since the EDD does not provide explicit units for the sql and state this in the DVSR.

**Response**: The EDD was reviewed and amended to reflect the same units for the: mdl, pql, sql and the analytical result. Future EDD submittals will omit: surrogates and internal standards (result\_type:SURR and IS) since results do not have mdls, sqls, or pqls, and the field mdl\_pql\_units was a Tronox addition to the EDD, is no longer necessary.

Comment: NDEP has noted 8 results where prep\_time and prep\_date are null (all for perchlorate). Please revise as necessary.

**Response**: The results table was amended by populating the prep\_time and prep\_date for all perchlorate analysis.
