Dear Mr. Dong,

At the direction of the Nevada Environmental Response Trust (Trust), ENVIRON reviewed the draft comments received from the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) on the *Post-Remediation Screening Health Risk Assessment Report for Parcels C, D, F, G and H, Revision 3* (HRArev3), dated June 19, 2014. The draft comments were transmitted from NDEP to the Trust in an e-mail dated February 5, 2015.

Following discussions with the Trust, Revision 3 of the HRA will be revised in response to the NDEP comments as outlined below:

ENVIRON, on behalf of the Trust, requests that NDEP exclude those comments listed in the last column of the above table from the final comment transmittal. As previously discussed with NDEP, it is anticipated that significant effort will be needed to revise the HRArev3 report to address these comments. At the same time, these requested revisions are not anticipated to change the overall conclusions of the HRA. This is particularly true for this HRA, in which the evaluation is based on the maximum detected concentrations across all parcels, providing a conservative estimate of potential risk and significantly reducing the need to provide some of the more detailed information or spatial analyses requested in the comments.

The report will be revised and submitted to NDEP for review within four months of receiving the final comments.
