Dear Compliance Coordinator:

The Nevada Environmental Response Trust (“NERT” or the “Trust”) maintains NPDES Permit NV0023060 for discharge of treated water, as part of our on-going effort to capture and treat groundwater containing perchlorate in the Henderson, Nevada area. Section A.2.1 of the NPDES Permit states: “The Permittee shall submit, for review by the Division, two (2) copies of any updated pages and/or sections of the Groundwater Extraction and Treatment System (GWETS) Operations and Maintenance (O&M) manual. The O&M manual update shall be prepared by a qualified person familiar with the system operations.”

Consistent with the NPDES Permit, NERT is submitting the attached updated O&M Manual for the NERT Perchlorate Treatment System, Revision 8 – June 2023, which has been revised by Envirogen Technologies, Inc. (Envirogen), the groundwater treatment plant operator, to add operating procedures for the Effluent Filtration System (EFS). As you are aware, the 100 percent design for the EFS was approved by NDEP on June 6, 2023. Due to the potential shutdown of the existing clean water supply, construction of the EFS was expedited and the system should be operational by July 21, 2023. According, NERT is submitting Revision 8 of the O&M Manual for the NERT Perchlorate Treatment System which includes operational procedures for the EFS.
