- C. Print the name of the person signing the application and enter the signer's authority, i.e., permittee or agent, on the fifth line.
- 1. Check the appropriate box regarding the permit owner(s)
- If you answered "Yes" to question 1, check the appropriate box. If you answered "No" to question 1, skip to question 4.
- 3. If you answered "No" to question 2, list the party or parties you are representing.
- 4. If the extension is for proof of completion of work, state the estimated time to complete the diversion works. If for proof of beneficial use, state the estimated time to complete the total project.
- 5. Furnish the amount of expenditures on work and equipment during the last year and the total to date.
- 6. The period of time requested may not exceed one year. Complete no. 6 by entering whether this request is for proof of completion of work and/or proof of beneficial use.
- NRS 533.380 3(b) states that an application for extension must in all cases be "Accompanied by <u>proof and evidence of the reasonable diligence</u> with which the applicant is pursuing the perfection of the application." Please provide specific information that documents reasonable diligence and steady application of effort to perfect the application. Highlight progress made during the previous year. Examples of this type of information follow:
 - 1) Describe any work in progress and any facility or feature completed.
 - 2) Specify any project reports or engineering drawings that have been submitted for review or recorded pursuant to applicable laws.

 - 7) Explain any adverse conditions and their affect upon the permittee's ability to establish full beneficial use.

This application is a sworn affidavit and must be signed by the person making the application and include his or her address and phone number in the spaces provided.

NOTE: Each application must appear with an original signature of the applicant or agent.

The application must be properly dated and notarized.

A separate application for extension of time is required for each permit.

The application for extension of time must be properly completed, signed, notarized and received in an office of the State Engineer, with the \$100.00 statutory filing fee, on or before the due date as set forth in the permit terms.
