

Dear Control Officer,

The Nevada Environmental Response Trust (NERT or the Trust) maintains Clark County Department of Air Quality Minor Source Permit 17249. The site, located near Henderson, Nevada, is a minor source of volatile organic compounds (VOCs) and hydrogen sulfide (H₂S). The source name listed on the original permit issued May 9, 2013 is Veolia Water North America – West, LLC (Veolia). A transition in treatment plant operators from Veolia to Envirogen Technologies, Inc. (Envirogen) occurred on July 24, 2013. ENVIRON, on behalf of the Trust, is submitting the enclosed application for a change of source name to Envirogen.
