Dear Control Officer,

The Nevada Environmental Response Trust (NERT or the Trust) maintains Clark County Department of Air Quality Minor Source Permit 17249. The site, located near Henderson, Nevada and owned by the Trust, is a minor source of volatile organic compounds (VOCs) and hydrogen sulfide (H₂S). The Minor Source Permit 17249 issued May 9, 2013 states as follows:

A transition in operators of the groundwater extraction and treatment system (GWETS) from Veolia Water North America – West, LLC (Veolia) to Envirogen Technologies, Inc. (Envirogen) occurred on July 24, 2013. ENVIRON, on behalf of the Trust, submitted an application dated September 11, 2013, for a change of Source name from Veolia to Envirogen. Subsequent to receiving the application, Rose Webster with Clark County Department of Air Quality called Kimberly Kuwabara with ENVIRON on September 13, 2013, to clarify the change that the Trust was requesting. Based on the conversation with Rose Webster, ENVIRON, on behalf of the Trust, request the permit be corrected/modified as follows:
