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NDEP Comment	Response to Comment
DVSR Comments	
1. <u>Section 1.0, Precision and Accuracy of Environmental Data:</u> In the third paragraph, please also cite the NDEP validation guidelines as the basis for validation.	The reference for the NDEP validation guidelines (July 2018) has been added to the third paragraph in Section 1.0, Precision and Accuracy of Environmental Data.
2. <u>Section 3.0 and Section 5.4, number of wet chemistry results:</u> The total number of results listed in these sections, 3,416, is inclusive of the unvalidated field pH data. As the DVSR details the results of validation, please exclude these results in the wet chemistry total and the grand total in Section 5.4.	The field pH results have been excluded from the number of results listed in Section 3.0 and Section 5.4. Section 3.0 now lists the number of results for wet chemistry methods as 3,040. Section 5.4 now lists the total analytes reported as 3,579 and number of results for wet chemistry methods as 3,040.
3. <u>Section 2.2.2 and Section 3.2.2, ICBs and CCBs:</u> Text in these sections indicate that ICB and CCB results were assessed; however, Table II notes these blanks were not assessed. Please revise either the text or table to resolve this inconsistency.	Table II has been revised to indicate that ICBs and CCBs were assessed.
EDD Comments	
1. The filtered_flag field in the results table has been updated to "TOTAL" and "DISSOLVED" in the revised EDD Guidance. This update should be reflected in all future EDDs. This does not require a revised EDD unless the DVSR comments are such that a revised EDD is needed.	The DVSR comments do not require a revised EDD. Future EDDs will reflect the updated guidance.
