<p><i>1. Section 1.0, sample count: The text states there are 354 water samples in this DVSR, however, the EDD Samples table has 329 samples not identified as FIELDQC. Please investigate this discrepancy and please determine if it also affects Table 2.</i></p>	<p>The EDD contains 361 samples consisting of 322 validated groundwater, 16 validated equipment blanks, 16 validated field blanks, and 7 unvalidated groundwater samples that were sent for microbial analysis only. Since the microbial data are not validated, they are not part of the Data Validation Summary Report and are not included in Table 2. They are included in the EDD because of NDEP requirements. Only the 354 validated samples are included in Table 2. The text has been updated to clarify the number of samples.</p>
