<p>1. The NERT is still investigating the OU-3, so NDEP reserves its comments on the sources to the perchlorate mass loading to the Las Vegas Wash until the completion of all remediation investigations.</p>	<p>The comment is noted.</p>
<p>2. Section 5.4 Completeness. The table lists 507 anion results reported. The EDD indicates two of those results (Nitrate) are flagged with "orr". The chromium VI, perchlorate, and chlorate results were reduced by the respective number of results flagged with "orr". Please present the total results reported consistently across all analyses. Check the total results for all analyte results and the total for anions. Please re-submit electronic DVSR with an explanation after addressing the inconsistency.</p>	<p>The DVSR completeness table in Section 5.4 lists a total of 507 anion results, which includes two results for Nitrate/Nitrite-N calculation, and does not include the two Nitrate results flagged DNR/orr in the EDD. For clarity and consistency with the 2020 Annual Groundwater Monitoring and GWETS Performance Report DVSR, the completeness table has been revised to list 505 anion results, and the Nitrate/Nitrite-N calculation results have been included on the line with the Total Inorganic Nitrogen calculation results for a total of 4. The total results for all analyte results and anions have been checked. Similarly, Table III has been revised to group the anion results separately from the calculated results for Nitrate/Nitrite-N and Total Inorganic Nitrogen.</p>
