At the direction of the Nevada Environmental Response Trust (NERT or Trust), Tetra Tech, Inc. (Tetra Tech) has prepared this memorandum to summarize Tetra Tech's progress during April 2023 toward successfully implementing the Las Vegas Wash Zero-Valent Iron (ZVI)-Enhanced Bioremediation Treatability Study.

Task Progress Update: April 2023

Task M18 – Las Vegas Wash ZVI-Enhanced Bioremediation Treatability Study

- Current Status
 - The installation of the continuous ZVI wall in Test Areas 1a/1b and discontinuous ZVI walls (ZVI-filled borings) in Test Areas 2a/2b/2c were completed in March 2023. The general treatability study layout and location of the continuous ZVI wall and discontinuous ZVI wall (ZVI borings) are presented in Figures 1, 2a, and 2b. A diagram presenting the profile of the continuous ZVI wall will be provided in future monthly progress reports once final field reporting is complete.
 - The installation of 16 injection wells and 61 post-construction monitoring wells began on March 15, 2023 and was completed on April 17, 2023. Well construction details and updated maps of the monitoring well network will be provided in the May 2023 monthly progress report once survey data are received.
 - A one-time injection event was performed from April 17 to April 24, 2023. The injectate solution was blended on-site and consisted of five components including a perchlorate inoculum culture prepared by SiREM, nutrients consisting of Accelerite provided by JRW Bioremediation and potassium phosphate, oxygen scavenger (sodium sulfite), and extracted groundwater. A summary of the injection quantities, rates and pressures for each injection well will be provided in the May 2023 monthly progress report after receipt of the final report from the injection contractor.
- Schedule and Progress Updates
 - Slug testing will be performed in all newly installed wells from May 15 to May 19, 2023.
 - The Month 1 performance monitoring event is tentatively scheduled to begin on May 22, 2023.
 Following this first sampling event, groundwater levels will be measured monthly and

groundwater samples will be collected quarterly to generate time-series data to evaluate the treatment effectiveness of the ZVI installations with respect to the design performance criteria.


